

## WHITE WINES

YELLOWTAIL SEMILLON SAUVIGNON BLANC (Australia) £12.50  
Fresh & zesty with a refreshing lemon-lime citrus tang that cleanses the palate. Another winner from the Yellowtail stable.

YELLOWTAIL CHARDONNAY (Australia) £12.50

The world's fastest growing brand, and is it any wonder? Lashings of tropical fruit salad wrapped in honeysuckle syrup. If you want to please everyone in your house (except the kids!), then plump for a bottle of this.

SANTA RITA SAUVIGNON BLANC (Chile) £12.50  
Crisp, refreshing and fruity, with delicate herbaceous undertones and a pleasant acidity. Excellent as an aperitif or with seafood.

WYNDHAM ESTATE CHARDONNAY (Australia) £15.50  
Quality aromatic, well-balanced wine with delicious peach and gentle oak flavours from this famous New South Wales Estate.

CASTILLERO DEL DIABLO SAUVIGNON BLANC (Chile) £14.50  
A crisp and fresh classical Chilean Sauvignon. Fruity, with a long complex finish.

STONELEIGH SAUVIGNON BLANC (New Zealand) £17.50  
The benchmark for Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc's, this stunning, pale straw wine displays lifted passion fruit aromas alongside crisp and succulent citrus flavours.

PINOT GRIGIO – CA LUNGHETTA (Italy) £15.50

This wine produced in North East Italy, is crisp and fresh with medium body. One of today's trendiest wines.

CHABLIS LA MARGUERITE – BURGUNDY (France) £20.50  
From Alain Geoffroy, one of Chablis's best producers, this classic wine has an intense bouquet, fat, well-rounded tastes and a long lingering finish.

THE NED SAUVIGNON BLANC (New Zealand) £18.50  
This has been described as by some wine journalists as "the purist of the pure Sauvignon Blanc's" Packed with ripe herbaceous notes, underpinned with a striking hint of citrus.

SANCERRE LA GUILBERTE (France) £21.50  
One of the world's most famous white wines this Sancerre is green gold in colour. Fragrant with attractive and ripe fruit flavours on the palate

## RED WINES

- YELLOWTAIL SHIRAZ (Australia)** £12.50  
Yellowtail Shiraz is deep purple in colour, leading to a nose of lifted berry aromas with spicy notes. A touch of vanillin oak adds balance and softness to the long, enjoyable finish. This Shiraz will complement most meat dishes.
- YELLOWTAIL MERLOT (Australia)** £12.50  
A Blue-Gold award for the Yellowtail Merlot in the Sydney International Wine Competition. Soft and sensuously smooth fruit delivery with a silky finish.
- SANTA RITA CABERNET SAUVIGNON (Chile)** £12.50  
The fruity aromas and fine concentration provide the ideal combination with red meats, pork, spicy sauces and cheese soufflés.
- WALLACE SHIRAZ/GRENACHE (Australia)** £22.50  
It exhibits a lovely perfume of cedar, tobacco, damp earth, black cherry and blueberry. A concentrated, structured wine with ripe blue and black fruit flavours, well-concealed tannin, and a long finish.
- CHIANTI COLLI SENESI DOCG (Italy)** £15.50  
A stylish wine, gentle but of fine structure, a very good example of a well made Chianti, extremely elegant, very smooth, well balanced.
- BEAUJOLAIS VILLAGES LES MERRAIN (Burgundy)** £16.50  
Produced by Pierre Ferraud, a long established producer of excellent Beaujolais, this wine has firm aromas of red fruit. Very traditional in style and how a good Beaujolais Villages should be.
- FLEURIE CRU BEAUJOLAIS (Burgundy)** £19.50  
This excellent Fleurie has the characteristic bouquet of crushed fruits with the supple generous flavours of the Gamay grape showing through.
- WYNDHAM ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON (Australia)** £15.50  
Superb rich blackcurrant and Vanilla flavours, well-rounded full and long lasting.
- CASTILLERO DEL DIABLO PINOT NOIR (Chile)** £14.50  
A medium to full bodied elegant wine from the noble Burgundian grape, ripe with soft fruit displaying intense aromas of strawberries and overtones of vanilla oak.
- CAMPO VIEJO RIOJA CRIANZA (Spain)** £14.50  
Crafted from Tempranillo, Granacha and Mazuelo vines, this delicious soft and fruit driven Rioja displays bright garnet with purple and gold hues. This aged wine is smooth and long lasting.
- CAMPO VIEJO RIOJA RESERVA (Spain)** £18.50  
Aged for a minimum of 3 years this stunning Reserve wine is created from Tempranillo, Granacha and Mazuelo vines. Winemaker Elena Adell is justifiably proud of this well rounded soft and generous Rioja.

## ROSE WINES

JACOBS CREEK SHIRAZ ROSE (Australia) £12.50  
Vibrant pink colour, attractive fresh berry flavours with a hint of soft spice are all the hallmarks of this excellent fruity wine.

SUTTER HOME ZINFANDEL (California) £13.50  
America's favourite premium wine. This delightfully fruity, naturally sweet blush wine has the aroma of fresh strawberries.

VEUVE CLICQUOT PONSARDIN BRUT (France) £51.00

CHATEAU GRAVAS SAUTERNES 37.5CL (France) £16.50  
Sauternes is the undisputed King of dessert wines and Chateau Gravas is a wonderful example, deep golden colour, a scented floral bouquet and beautiful sweet intense taste of honey and limes.

## HALF BOTTLE SELECTION

### WHITE WINE

SACRED HILL SEMILLON CHARDONNAY (Australia) £8.50  
The classic Australian combination of fruit filled Chardonnay and full-bodied Semillon perfectly executed to give a wine, which drinks well by itself or with food.

LE RIME PINOT GRIGIO/CHARDONNAY (Italy) £8.50  
From Castello Banfi (voted 6 times Italian Winery of the Year) an unusual combination of the aromatic Pinot Grigio and full-bodied Chardonnay. Very fruity and fragrant. 89 SCORE by Robert Parker - the world's most influential wine critic.

VEUVE CLICQUOT PONSARDIN BRUT (France) £25.50  
Beautiful golden yellow colour reflects aromas of white fruits, vanilla and brioche. The well structured wine initially delivers freshness and forcefulness so typical of "Yellow Label" with a symphony of fruit following on.

### RED WINE

SACRED HILL SHIRAZ CABERNET (Australia) £8.50  
A lovely blend of Shiraz and Cabernet, spicy and full flavoured with an abundance of fruit, with a long finish.

CHATEAU LAMARCHE BORDEAUX SUPERIOR (France) £8.50  
From one of Bordeaux's oldest vineyards, originally planted by the Romans, this wine is deep in colour, fruit heavy and rich.

## SPECIALITY WINE

### WHITE WINES

CHABLIS PREMIER CRU FOURCHAUME (France) £30.50  
A superb example of Chablis at it's best, brilliant, and luminous in colour. Rich and rounded and buttery.

CHATEAU DE TRACY POUILLY FUME– LOIRE VALLEY (France) £30.50  
Perhaps the finest Pouilly Fume available in Ireland today – need we say more?

MEURSAULT – ROUX PERE ET FILS, BURGUNDY (France) £40.50  
The Roux family have been producing fine Meursaults for 5 generations – this classic Burgundy white is very rich and concentrated, lingers long on the palate and is a very fine 'food wine'.

### RED WINES

CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE DOMAINE DUCLAUX – RHONE (France) £30.50  
Good backbone, full in the mouth with a fine bouquet and generous finish. 4 Stars Wine Ireland Magazine.

NUITS-SAINT-GEORGES DOMAINE DES PERDRIX (France) £60.50  
From one of Burgundy's finest producers of Nuits-Saint-Georges this wine is deep ruby-red in colour with a fine nose and round and ample on the palate.
